
However, the true strength of an institution lies in its students. I urge each one of you to uphold the values of discipline, respect, integrity, and responsibility.

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
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Honours and Accolades

Chapter 5

Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV) in the Pediatric Population

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Abstract

One important respiratory pathogen influencing the paediatric population worldwide is human metapneumovirus (HMPV). Originally discovered in 2001, HMPV is connected to bronchiolitis, pneumonia, and aggravation of children’s asthma in acute respiratory tract infections (ARTIs). It is a major cause of hospitalisation in young children and newborns and has clinical parallels with respiratory syncytial virus (RSV). By the time they are five, almost all children have HMPV; severe cases arise in individuals with underlying medical problems or compromised immune systems. With a seasonal rhythm, HMPV mostly circulates in late winter and early spring. With occasional death in high-risk categories, it greatly adds to paediatric morbidity. Given the restrictions of conventional viral culture techniques, diagnosis mostly depends on molecular techniques such as RT-PCR. There isn’t any particular antiviral treatment or vaccination available right now; management is still supportive. The epidemiology, clinical presentation, and diagnostic difficulties of HMPV in children are covered in this

WORKSHOP- INTRODUCTION TO SEMICONDUCTORS



