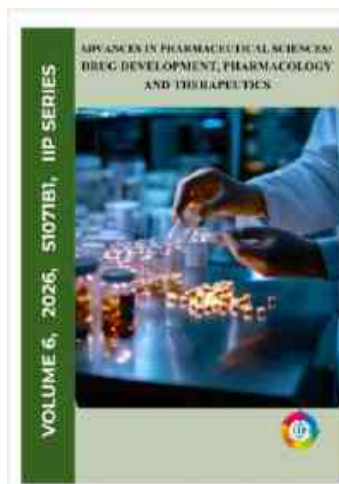
Editorial Leadership in Pharmaceutical Sciences

A notable achievement reflecting his growing role in the academic publishing community.



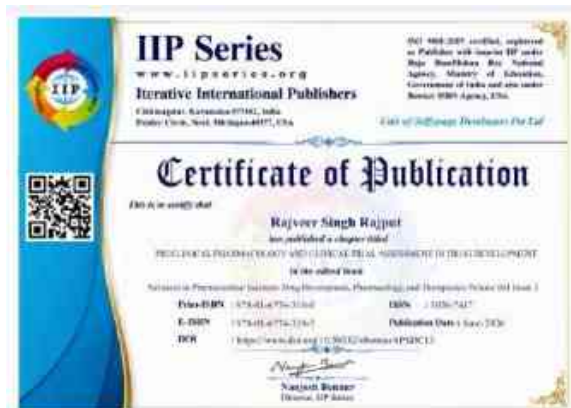
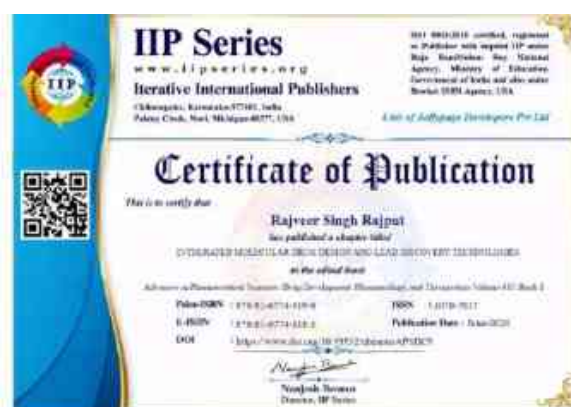

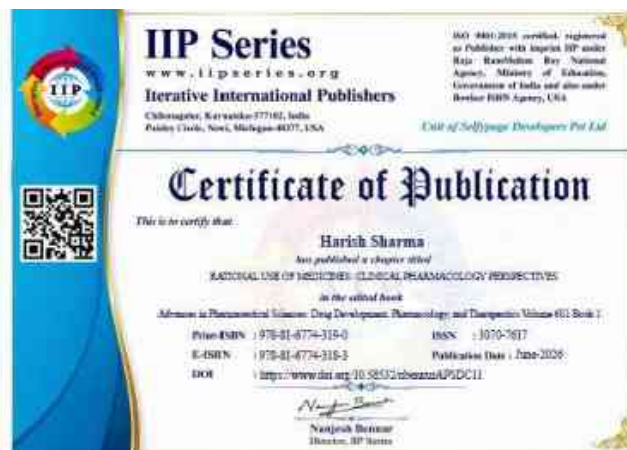
Harish Sharma Publishes Chapter on Clinical Pharmacology

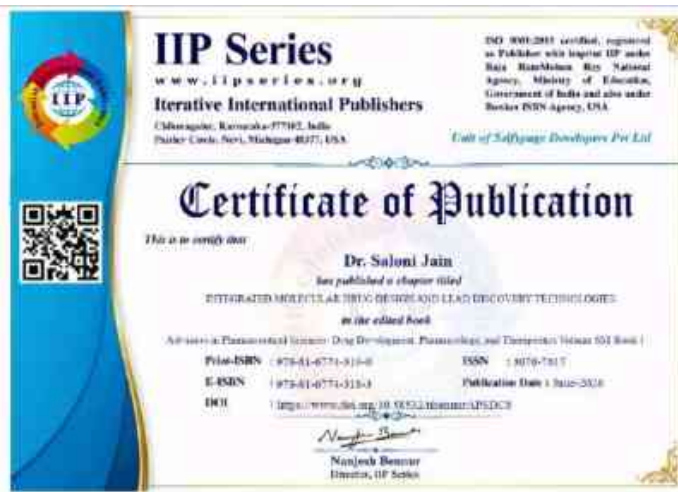
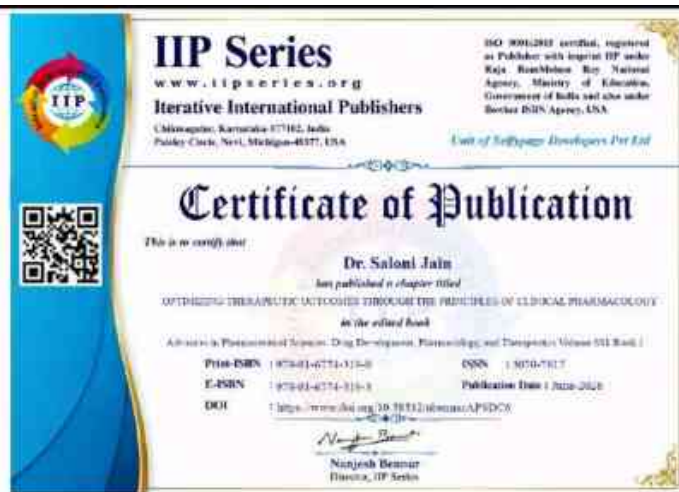
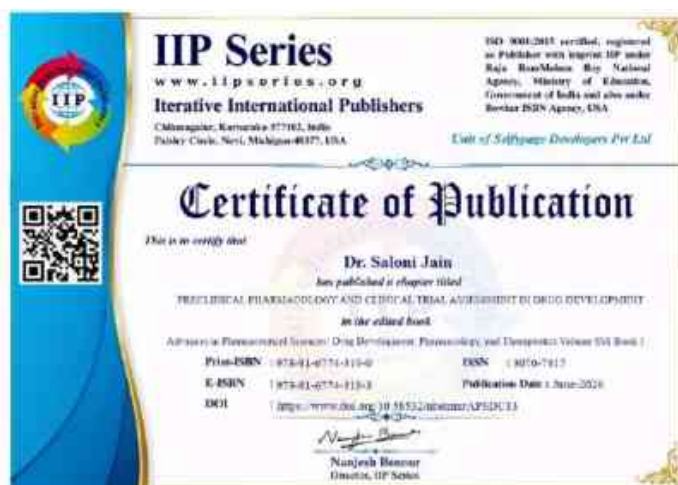

Abstract

A nomenclature (ideal) problem-solving model has been developed as a guide for the rational selection and prescription of medications. It consists of a series of steps or actions: decide on the treatment's objective, select a (drug/treatment), begin drug treatment, track the outcomes, make conclusions, decide what more needs to be done, and stop, modify, or continue treatment. The proper application of pharmacological facts and fundamental principles within the context of the entire problem-solving process is one of the cognitive skills required. These results imply that the theoretical model can be helpful in interpreting empirical data in order to better explain the steps in their therapeutic decision-making process to others, particularly their patients and colleagues. Pharmacy educators can use the results to create educational opportunities that teach students about therapeutic decision-making. The scientific study of how medications and other substances interact with living systems to produce both beneficial and harmful effects is known as pharmacology. It is a fundamental science that provides the information required for the sensible and secure use of medications by bridging the gap between chemistry, biology, and medicine. Any undesirable side effects of drugs (medications) are known as adverse drug reactions or adverse effects, examining lab results, medical history, patient-centered objectives, psychosocial aspects, and pertinent literature.

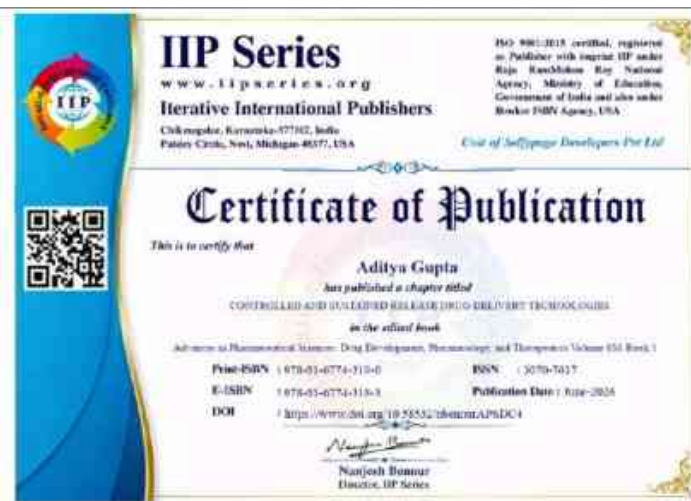
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Advancing Novel Drug Delivery Research

The publication highlights continued faculty engagement with emerging drug delivery approaches.





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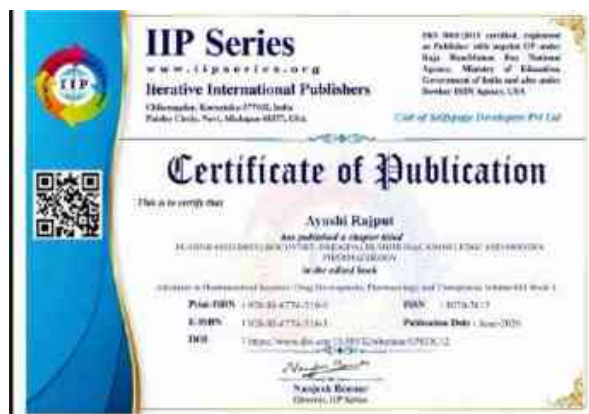

Dr. Vinay Jain Receives Elsevier Reviewing Certificates

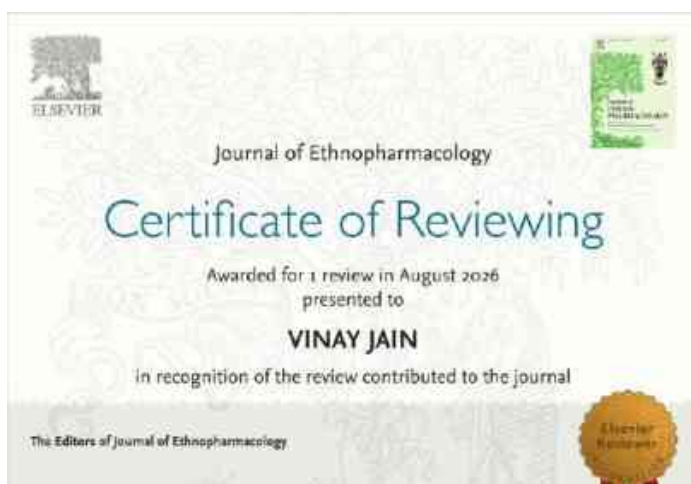
