Seminar on Health and Hygiene Training for Girls

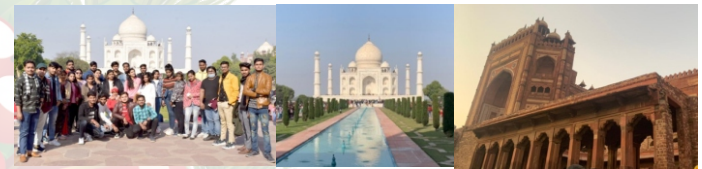
Educational Visit to Sewage Water Treatment Plant

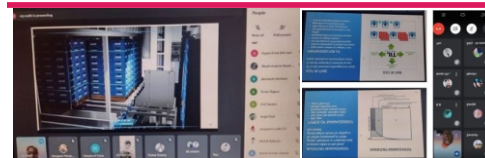
Trip of SRIPS 3rd year

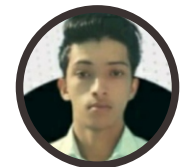

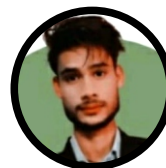

5. Why is this position vacant?
