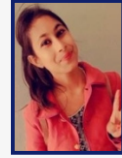

*There can either be life or there can be drugs because both cannot go hand in hand.*

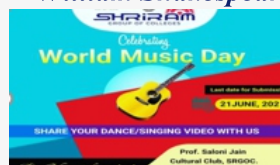


On 24 June which is an "International Day against Drug abuse and illicit trafficking", Prof. Megha Jain of SRCP organized a Poster Making Competition.

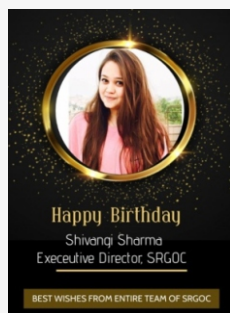

*“Social awareness is also necessary”*

that people should become aware of the government schemes and utilize the same. Patient counseling is another very important point. Doctor to patient ratio in developing nations is very low. According to Times of India: “The average time that India's neighborhood doctors, called primary care consultants spend with patients is a negligible two minutes.” Evidently, there is a need that patient must be told what needs to be done. Whenever possible, we (at SRCP) release campaigns, publish videos and organize social awareness drive to let the people know how medication errors can be minimized. Lastly, it must be ensured that students must learn ethical values along with formal education. Then only will India become a powerful nation.

### Faculty Achievement



Adina Group of Institutions invited Prof. Vikas Shukla of Civil department from SRIIT to deliver a guest lecture on the topic The Analytic Hierarchy Process (AHP) on 31 May. He informed students that how AHP is a method for organizing and analyzing complex decisions, using math and psychology. AHP provides a rational framework for a needed decision by quantifying its criteria and alternative options, and for relating those elements to the overall goal. AHP converts all possible evaluations on a problem into numbers, which can be compared to all of the possible criteria. This quantifying capability distinguishes the AHP from other decision making techniques for complex problems. Rather than prescribing a "correct" decision, AHP helps decision makers find one that best suits their values and their understanding of the problem. It was all about the application of AHP in engineering decision making process. It was common for all branches of Engineering along with numerical analysis of complex multi objective decision making problem of any field. The Director of Adina Group Dr. Sunil Jain & chairman of the Adina group expressed their pleasure on successful completion of the session.
