According to Ms. Bhardwaj Gandhiji demanded Poorna Swaraj or Complete Freedom in that Movement. A Flag was Hoisted by Aruna Ali On 9th August 1942. Many More were Arrest On following Freedom Fighters Like Nehru ji Gandhiji and Sardar Patel. After all Quit India Movement surely remains a very Important Mile stones in India's Freedom Struggle. At last, she said that- On Quit India Movement Day, “Let us remember the sacrifice made our Leaders for the sake of Independence”.
