The motto of the club was to make a positive impact on our environment!" "Prakrati Prem Utsav" was a resounding success.

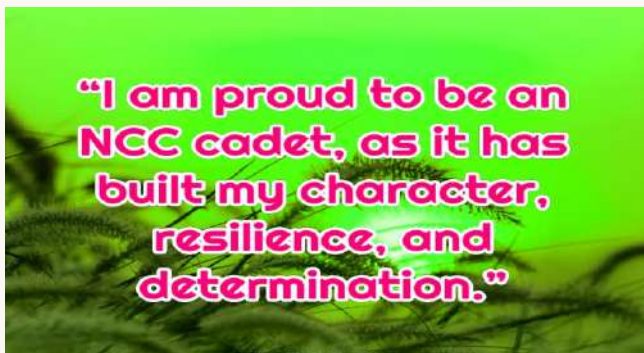
